Things to do when you get to a "Tricky Word"

- 1. Get your mouth ready. Make the first sound for the letter or the chunk.
- 2. Look at the picture.
- 3. Reread.



- 4. Look for a part of the word you know.
 - go be no <u>go</u>ing <u>be</u>gan <u>no</u>where

- 5. Search through the word. Make the sounds you know.
- 6. Read on to the end of the sentence. Then go back and fix the "tricky word."

THINK: Does it make sense? Does it sound right (like talking) Does it look right?



RULE: Don't give the word. Give the strategies.
